I. SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

Sec	Description of Contract Change
2.G	Modify Co-terminals definition. Co-terminal sequences shall originate and terminate at the same airport.
2.I	Delete Credited Projection (PROJ) and all references to same
2.BB	Add Operating Experience (OE) Displacement definition (in line with TA on Q&A 53).
2.GG	Modify the definition of Reassignment. Include any time flown outside the footprint of a sequence treated as a reassignment and paid a rate of 1.5 times the applicable hourly rate.
2.II	Modify the definition of Reschedule. Modifications within the footprint of a sequence as a result of a disruption to the pilot's original sequence treated as reschedules. Any time flown outside the footprint of a sequence treated as a reassignment.
2.KK	Include Satellite Base provisions to allow for lines to contain more than one sequence that originate from different airports, in conjunction with a schedule change (up to 2 airports in any line with a single transaction during the month).
2.MM	Modify Scheduled Projection (SPROJ) definition --treat downline reassignments for International same as Domestic. Eliminate VJA reference.
2.OO	Add the definition of Sequence Protection to define pay protections. Reduced make-up obligation on the pilot from previous proposal.
2.PP	Add the definition of Sequence Footprint for Domestic and International
2.RR	Modify Sick if Needed definition to eliminate the ability for a pilot at the beginning of each subsequent month to revert back to sick if needed status (no change to previous proposal).

4.E	Delete Cancellation of Last Trip of the Month

V. SECTION 11.E: Leaves of Absence – Military Service Leaves

Sec	Description of Contract Change
11.E	Make all military removals uncredited. Eliminate guarantee for military leave protection in line with OALs.
11.E.5	Modified language re late notice and notice of change to be submitted to the Company as soon as practicable instead of by the bid sheet deadline date.
11.E.8.b	Eliminate reserve pilot's guarantee protection. For line holders, add military leave credit at 2:45 per day towards line credit with adjustment to PPROJ and pilot option to change these days to uncredited.
11.E.8.c /d	See 11.e.5; Reserve pilot option to move DFPs to cover military leave days to restore guarantee or reduce pilot guarantee by 3:50 for each day the reserve is unavailable.
11.E.9	Removals uncredited at pilot option.

Sec	Description of Contract Change
15.A.1	Change monthly maximum to annual bidline average of 82 scheduled hrs. Monthly max for reserve pilots changed to scheduled projection (SPROJ) instead of credited projection (PROJ).
15.A.2.c	Delete VJA (Voluntary Junior Assignment); add reference to SEP
15.A.3.a	Make-up and trip trading limitations at 87 hours with Company option to increase to 92. Delete reference to PROJ.
15.A.3.d.1	Changed references to monthly max and PROJ
15.A.4 and 15.A.5	Eliminate PROJ references
15.A.6	Eliminate CPA bank reference and related fly through time for credited PROJ and SPROJ. Added that fly-through time shall be credited towards the subsequent month's bidline credit for line construction, and then becomes uncredited.
15.B.2, Letter A	Modified Company proposal on recording of telephone calls. Eliminate Letter A.
15.B.3.b	Clarified that changes made to allocations inside of 24 hrs of bid closing shall be subject to Sequence Cancellation Protection.
15.B.3.c	Delete availability of projected crew assignments (old language - no longer relevant)
15.C	Added pilot discretion to extend duty day
15.C.1	Modify On Duty Time limitations based on departure time
15.C.3.a and b	Eliminate 9:30 layover rest exception for up to 18 monthly rest periods
15.C.3.c	Delete language per co-terminal/ satellite modification
15.C	Delete diurnal exception (5 hour break within duty period)
15.D	Off Duty Time: Modified and moved to Section 18
15.D.3	Eliminate 10 hr rest exception following training to remain in line with home-based rest requirements. [Need to modify section 6]
15.E.2	Eliminate 2 hrs flight time pay and credit – pay average day or E time, as applicable  If scheduled sit time is >= 2 hrs, added pay at rate of 1: 2 minutes in excess of 2 hrs; Eliminate E time exceptions

15.F.1.b	Time Away From Base: Added 1: 3.25 pay only for sequences with greater calendar days than duty period for multi-duty period sequences based on actual time away from base (excludes single duty period sequences)
15.H.9	Eliminate deadheading language (no longer required as a result of E.2. deletion)

Sec	Description of Contract Change
A and B	Re-write language to account for PBS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monthly bidline average not to exceed 82 hours (annually)</li> <li>• Max bidline of 87 hrs</li> <li>• 2 month window</li> <li>• Off duty time incorporated from Section 15 with some modifications.</li> <li>• 2:45 daily credit for training/vacation for line construction</li> <li>• Make all days the same (rid of immovables and goldens)</li> </ul>
B	TDY – eliminated language on 1 trip sequence only; otherwise unchanged
